

Summary of Coloma Township Ordinance 2008-1 pertaining to the Regulation of water traffic, boating and water sports upon the waters of Pleasant Lake, located in the Town of Coloma, Waushara County, Wisconsin and the Town of Springfield, Marquette County, Wisconsin.

Section 3.

State of Wisconsin Boating and Safety Laws Adopted

State of Wisconsin boating laws as found in Sections 30.50 and 30.71, Wisconsin Statutes, together with amendments thereto, are adopted by reference.

Section 7.

Swimming and Water Skiing

(1) **Time:** Water skiing, aquaplaning and similar activities are allowed only between the hours of 11:00AM and 3:00PM daily on Pleasant lake.

(2) **Use of Personal Flotation Device:** No person shall engage in water skiing, aquaplaning, or similar activities unless they are wearing a United States Coast Guard Approved flotation device.

(3) **Swimming Distance From Shore:** No person shall swim more than 200 feet from shore unless accompanied by a competent person in a boat and having readily available a United States Coast Guard approved Personal Flotation device for each person on board and in the water.

(4) **Floating Devices:** No person shall float more than 200 feet from shore in or on an inner tube or similar floating device unless accompanied by a competent person in a boat having readily available a United States Coast Guard approved Personal Flotation Device for each person on the floating device and in the boat.
